Epiphany is a ministry for boys between the ages of 10 and 15 who are incarcerated at the Bill Clayton Detention Center, a maximum security facility at Littlefield. The first one at this facility was held in early August with Sheri Short as Lay Director and Frank Saldana as Spiritual Director. Six of the boys who participated in this weekend attended the September Llano Estacado Community meeting, and shared what the weekend meant to them. They were accompanied by Jean Tomlinson, Facility Administrator at BCDC, who is also a member of the Llano community. The team consists of members of both the Llano Estacado and New Horizon communities, as well as other communities around the state. The boys participate in follow-up mentoring sessions with some of the team members each Tuesday night at BCDC, where they discuss their walk with Christ that week. They share scriptures they have read, and list their prayer concerns. A monthly Epiphany community meeting takes place on the third Saturday of the month, where they have Praise and Worship, devotionals, and do projects such as make agape for upcoming Kairos. Since the Epiphany weekend, behavior has improved in the facility, and Bible Studies are taking place in the dorms. In Christ's Name, Bruce Slaughter
